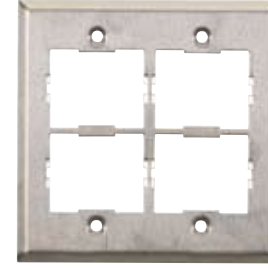

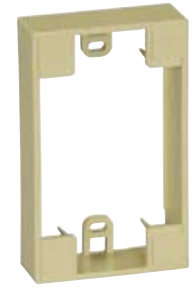

OVERVIEW

With our faceplates, you can mount up to four couplers on a wall or to a surface-mount box. They are available in white, gray, and ivory.

To cover mounting screws and provide instant identification, write-on designation labels are included.

The faceplates come in plastic or stainless-steel versions, and they can be mounted to a wall, a surface-mount box, or a Standoff Ring.

Standoff Rings are used with installations that need extra space behind the faceplate. The 1" ring ensures the proper bend radius for optical fiber or other multimedia applications.
