## OVERVIEW

Save space and keep your video monitors safe!

### Frames with Ceiling Mount

- With these models, the monitor is suspended 6" from the ceiling. If a longer drop is required, you can use 1.5", schedule-40 threaded pipe.

### Frames with Wall Mount

- Weight capacity—RM935: 200 pounds, RM933: 250 pounds, RM943: 300 pounds.
- Provide a full 40" pivot plus a 355° swivel for optimum viewing.

### Cathedral Ceiling Mount

- Weight capacity of 300 pounds.
- For use with angled ceilings.
- Holds RM931 or RM941 frames.
- Pivots up to 90°.

### Double-Stud Wall Mounts

- Weight capacity—RM937: 300 pounds, RM938: 275 pounds.
- Extra-wide mounting plate spans two studs on 16" or 24" centers.
- Hold RM931 or RM941 frames.

### Video Equipment Mount

- Attaches to the underside of any monitor mount frame.
- Holds equipment such as VCRs, DVD players, or satellite receivers.
- Width is adjustable from 14" to 17"; depth is adjustable from 4" to 5".
